Lesson Text: Exodus 17:8-16

Related Scriptures: Deuteronomy 25:17-19; Psalm 83:1-18;

TIME: 1445 B.C.

PLACE: Rephidim

GOLDEN TEXT: "And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed" (Exodus 17:11 KJV)

Scripture Lesson Text

Exodus 17:8-16

⁸Then came Amalek, and fought with Israel in Rephidim.

⁹ And Moses said unto Joshua, choose us out men, and go out, fight with Amalek: tomorrow I will stand on the top of the hill with the rod of God in mine hand.

¹⁰ So Joshua did as Moses had said to him, and fought with Amalek: and Moses, Aaron, and Hur went up to the top of the hill.
