God Judges the Sin ¹

Lesson Text: Exodus 32:25-35

Related Scriptures: Psalm 85:10-13; Revelation 21:22-27

TIME: 1445 B.C.

PLACE: Mount Sinai

GOLDEN TEXT: *“The Lord said unto Moses, whosoever hath sinned against me, him will I blot out of my book.” (Exodus 32:33KJV)*

Scripture Lesson Text

Exodus 32:25-35

25 When Moses saw that the people were naked; (for Aaron had made them naked unto their shame among their enemies:)

26 Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, who is on the Lord's side? let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him.

27 He said unto them, thus saith the Lord God of Israel, Put every man his sword by his side, and go in and out from gate to gate throughout the camp, and slay every man his brother, and every man his companion, and every man his neighbour.

28 The children of Levi did according to the word of Moses: and there fell of the people that day about three thousand men.

29 For Moses had said, consecrate yourselves today to the Lord, even every man upon his son, and upon his brother; that he may bestow upon you a blessing this day.

30 It came to pass on the morrow, that Moses said unto the people, Ye have sinned a great sin: and now I will go up unto the Lord; peradventure I shall make an atonement for your sin.

31 Moses returned unto the Lord, and said, Oh, this people have sinned a great sin, and have made them gods of gold.

32 Yet now, if thou wilt forgive their sin--; and if not, blot me, I pray thee, out of thy book which thou hast written.

33 The Lord said unto Moses, whosoever hath sinned against me, him will I blot out of my book.

34 Therefore now go, lead the people unto the place of which I have spoken unto thee: behold, mine Angel shall go before thee: nevertheless, in the day when I visit I will visit their sin upon them.

35 The Lord plagued the people, because they made the calf, which Aaron made.

Lesson Aim

Facts: To see how God Judged Israel's sin.

Principle: To know that God judges sin and that He alone sees it as it really is.

Application: To realize that God sees and judges our sin, and to thank Him for His priceless gift of salvation.

Introduction

Israel failed to obey God. They worshipped a god made of gold. One truth to keep in mind is that all of God's discipline is meant to lead us to repentance, restore us to fellowship with Him, and help us to learn and grow in our commitment to His ways.

I. Developing the Lesson

- a. Moses handles the sinful situation (Exodus 32:25-29)
- b. Moses goes to God (Exodus 32:30-32)
- c. God informs Moses of His course of action (Exodus 32:33-35)

II. Studying the Text

Jesus said, the great among us are those who serve others (Mark 10:42-45). Moses was not perfect, but he was a selfless leader of a selfish people. As such, he was a model of what we should each aspire to be.
