The candidate must demonstrate qualities found in Acts 6 and 1 Timothy 3. (No candidate is perfect or demonstrates all of these qualities)

- 1. Does the candidate have a morally good reputation in and out of church that demonstrates a devotion to Christ? (1 Timothy 3:2; Titus 1:6; 1 Timothy 3:7) Y/N
- 2. Is the candidate a good example in the home (1 Timothy 3:2, 4, Titus 1:6)? Y/N
- 3. Is the candidate mature (1 Timothy 3:2, 6; Titus 1:6-8), and conduct oneself in a spirit of gentleness and forbearance when under pressure? Y/N
- 4. Does the candidate demonstrate love, spirituality, compassion (1 Timothy 3:2, 3; Titus 1:7, 8), and an attitude of service (1 Timothy 3:3; Titus 1:7)? Y/N
- 5. Is the candidate faithful in attendance at Sunday Services, Sunday School, and Bible Study? The potential candidate should have a record of regular attendance at Sunday School and Sunday Services. **Periodic attendance at Bible Study is required.** Y/N

- 7. Has the candidate been a member in good standing of FMZ for at least three years? Y/N

- 10. Is the candidate faithful in attendance at special church events and zone activities? Y/N

- 13. Is the candidate accessible, approachable, and available for service—not encumbering or entangling oneself in the affairs of this life (2 Timothy 2:4 and Luke 17:7-10)? Y/N
