The Reverend Doctor Gregory M. Howard Pastor, Union Branch Baptist Church, Chesterfield, VA. will return to FMZ as this year's Revivalist. Revival will be held Tuesday, August 3rd through Thursday, August 5th each night at 7:30pm. The Rev. Dr. Gregory M. Howard is a native of Lancaster, Virginia and currently resides in Hampton Roads, Virginia. Dr. Howard is the Senior Pastor of Union Branch Baptist Church in Chesterfield, Virginia where he promotes kingdom-like living by unconditionally loving God and all of God's people. Pastor Howard has also served as Senior Pastor of First Baptist Church East End in Newport News, Virginia and Jerusalem Baptist Church in Sparta, Virginia. In addition, Dr. Howard has served as the Interim Dean and Associate Professor of Homiletics and Practical Theology at the Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology. Dr. Howard is also the most recent past President of the Baptist General Convention of Virginia.

Pastor Howard holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Organizational Management and Development (Bluefield College), Master of Divinity degree (Virginia Union University), and a Doctor of Ministry degree in Preaching (Aquinas Institute of Theology at St. Louis University). He is the author of *Black Sacred Rhetoric: The Gospel According Religious Folk Talk* and *Voices Crying Out in the Wilderness: Theological Reflections Where Context Matters*. Civically, he is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Inc. Above all, Pastor Howard loves God and the challenge of helping others see God's grace in their own lives by proclaiming that Jesus Christ is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Rev. Howard believes that we have been blessed with life and created in the image of God to be with and for one another; therefore, he strives to tear

down the many obstacles that keep us from coming together in godly communion. Dr. Howard shares the joy of four children with his wife, the Reverend Kimberly Gonxhe.

ATTENTION ALL ZOOM MEETING HOSTS In order to protect our ministries from potential “Zoom bombing” by miscreants and hackers, it is no longer recommended to post meeting I.D.’s and pass codes to the website or social media. As an alternative, Zoom offers a registration feature for meeting participants to register for a meeting using a registration link. Once the registration link is established by the host, the link can be shared as usual via Connection Points, email, text etc. The organizer/host will receive a roster of registrants and if necessary, can use the list to verify people before they are allowed in the meeting.

Please check the FMZ website regularly for a complete listing of ministry activity and updates regarding weather closings during office hours. As always, during these times of uncertainty safety is of the utmost importance as we do our best to keep the congregation connected and informed while maintaining the health and welfare of all. Please check your email and the Church website for regular updates. Looking forward to our return in the future!

FEMA provides funeral assistance for COVID-19 related deaths. FRAUD ALERT: Note, FEMA will only contact those who have applied for benefits.

Criteria to apply for benefits:

- An applicant may apply for multiple deceased individuals.
- The COVID-19-related death occurred in the United States, U.S. Territories, or District of Columbia.
- This assistance cannot exceed a maximum financial amount of \$9,000 per funeral and a maximum of \$35,500 per application.
- Funeral assistance will assist with expenses incurred for funeral services, interment, or cremation.

In the coming weeks, FEMA will provide a dedicated 800 toll-free telephone number to help individuals with their applications. In the meantime, we encourage potential applicants to begin gathering the following documentation:

- An official death certificate that attributes the death to COVID-19 and shows that the death occurred in the United States. The death certificate must indicate the death “may have been caused by” or “was likely the result of” COVID-19 or COVID-19 like symptoms. FEMA considers similar phrases that indicate a high likelihood of COVID-19 as a sufficient attribution.
- Funeral expense documents (receipts, funeral home contract, and so on) that include the applicant’s name, deceased individual’s name, amount of funeral expenses, and the date you incurred the funeral expenses.
- Proof of funds received from other sources specifically for use toward funeral costs. Funeral assistance may not duplicate benefits received from burial or funeral insurance, financial assistance received from voluntary agencies, federal/state/local/tribal/territorial government or agency programs, or other sources.
