Vanco On-line Giving

VANCO, FMZBC's on-line giving platform, operates with a high level of security. As a result, users' access will be temporarily denied when using a VPN, virtual personal network, and because of too many failed login attempts. If you've forgotten your password, after some time the account will reset to allow you to select the forgot password option. Another option is to call the office with your IEP address. The office will then contact VANCO with the IP address to have your VANCO account reset.

COVID-19 Test Kit Distribution Saturday, January 22, 2022, 10:00 am-1:00 pm

First Mount Zion Baptist Church has partnered with, iHealth Labs to obtain 2,000 COVID-19 Antigen Rapid Tests. The test is authorized by the US Food and Drug Administration for non-prescription home use for those with symptoms of COVID-19. Given the number of tests available to us, the distribution will be to individual, active FMZ members only, with a limit of two test kits per household on a first come, first serve basis. Note, each member will only receive one test kit. No more than two members from a single household will be given a test kit. A member may not pick up a kit for another member.

Who is a member? A member has an FMZ issued 2-4, digit member number. Note: A 5-digit number is not an FMZ member number. If you need clarification, please call the office.

Member's name must be on the active church roster. Active roster includes members who have regular attendance/participation in ministry activity; and/or in regular contact with their zone leader; and/or give regularly.

Member's home address must be current on the roster.

Distribution will occur on Saturday; January 22 from 10 am to 1pm.

Upon arrival you will be directed to the drive through area to pick up the test kits.

To facilitate the drive thru pick up of test kits, please be prepared by having your member number and address readily available.

Change in Check-In Procedures Revised 9/12/21

For anyone 12 years and older proof of being fully vaccinated is required. Proof of vaccination is only required once. Once proof is shown your name will be entered into a data base. At subsequent check-ins you need only to provide your name. Wearing a mask, having temperature taken, and social distancing are required.

Am I required to pre-register for Sunday service or to enter the building?

No, providing verification of being fully vaccinated eliminates the need to preregister.

What forms of proof of vaccination are accepted? A legible vaccination card showing your name and date(s) of vaccination; a copy of your card; or a picture on your electronic device are acceptable forms of proof.

Are children required to show proof of vaccination? Children 12 years and older are required to show proof of vaccination. Children under the age of 12 are not.

What if I have a medical condition that prevents me from being vaccinated? In lieu of a vaccination card, provide medical documentation from a physician stating the medical exemption.

How do I get my name into the database? Upon your next arrival to the Church, for any reason, show proof of being fully vaccinated and your name will be added to the database.
