Jesus by the Sea of Tiberias¹

Lesson Text: **John 21:1-14**

Related Scriptures:

Luke 5:1-11; John 20:19-29; John 21:15-25;

TIME: A.D. 30

PLACES: Sea of Tiberias

GOLDEN TEXT: *“This is now the third time that Jesus shewed himself to his disciples, after that he was risen from the dead.”(John 21:14 KJV)*

Scripture Lesson Text

John 21:1-14

1 After these things Jesus shewed himself again to the disciples at the sea of Tiberias; and on this wise shewed he himself.

2 There were together Simon Peter, and Thomas called Didymus, and Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, and the sons of Zebedee, and two other of his disciples.

3 Simon Peter saith unto them, I go a fishing. They say unto him, We also go with thee. They went forth, and entered into a ship immediately; and that night they caught nothing.

4 But when the morning was now come, Jesus stood on the shore: but the disciples knew not that it was Jesus.

5 Then Jesus saith unto them, Children, have ye any meat? They answered him, No.

6 And he said unto them, Cast the net on the right side of the ship, and ye shall find. They cast therefore, and now they were not able to draw it for the multitude of fishes.

7 Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved saith unto Peter, It is the Lord. Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he girt his fisher's coat unto him, (for he was naked,) and did cast himself into the sea.

8 And the other disciples came in a little ship; (for they were not far from land, but as it were two hundred cubits,) dragging the net with fishes.

9 As soon then as they were come to land, they saw a fire of coals there, and fish laid thereon, and bread.

10 Jesus saith unto them, Bring of the fish which ye have now caught.

11 Simon Peter went up, and drew the net to land full of great fishes, an hundred and fifty and three: and for all there were so many, yet was not the net broken.

12 Jesus saith unto them, Come and dine. And none of the disciples durst ask him, Who art thou? knowing that it was the Lord.

13 Jesus then cometh, and taketh bread, and giveth them, and fish likewise.

14 This is now the third time that Jesus shewed himself to his disciples, after that he was risen from the dead.

Lesson Aim

Facts: To confirm that Jesus Christ rose from the dead and on the third day and appeared to His disciples.

Principle: To recognize that Jesus' resurrection was physical and guarantees life to all who believe in Him.

Application: To know the power of Jesus' resurrection by firmly trusting that He is the giver of life to those who believe in Him (cf. John 6:25-36; 14:19).

Introduction

The resurrection of Jesus was not something the disciples came up with by putting their heads together on the subject. It is a historical reality that can be verified through historical research, including multiple eyewitness accounts. Jesus rose from the dead and made appearances to his disciples.
