GOLDEN TEXT: "For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ." (1st Corinthians 3:11 KJV)

#### Scripture Lesson Text

#### 1st Corinthians 3:10-23

10 According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon.

- 11 For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ.
- 12 Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble;
- 13 Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is.
- 14 If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward.
- 15 If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.
- 16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?
- 17 If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are.
- 18 Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you seemeth to be wise in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be wise.

#### Lesson Aim

Facts: to be reminded that Christ is the believer's only foundation.

**Principle:** To understand what it means to have no other foundation than Christ.

**Application:** To make sure we faithfully build only upon Christ's foundation, realizing that the church is God's holy temple.
