Lesson Text: 1st Corinthians 15:1-11

<u>Related Scriptures:</u> Matthew 28:1-9; Mark 16:1-13; Luke 24:1-49 John 20:1-18; Acts 1:3-4; 1st Corinthians 15:12-28

TIME: A.D. 55

PLACES: from Ephesus

GOLDEN TEXT: "For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; and that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures.". (1st Corinthians 15:3-4 KJV)

Scripture Lesson Text

1st Corinthians 15:1-11

1 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;

2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.

3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;

4 And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

5 And that he was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve:

6 After that, he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.

7 After that, he was seen of James; then of all the apostles.

8 And last of all he was seen of me also, as of one born out of due time.

9 For I am the least of the apostles, that am not meet to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

10 But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which was bestowed upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.

11 Therefore whether it were I or they, so we preach, and so ye believed.

Lesson Aim

Facts: To learn the essential truths about Christ's resurrection.

Principle: To understand that Christ's resurrection is surely attested historical event.

Application: To consciously live daily in the realization of Christ's resurrection.
