Printed Text: John 12:44-50; Devotional Reading: John 5:19-24

<u>Keep in Mind:</u> "I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth in Me should not abide in darkness" (*John 12:46, KJV*)

Focal Verses

John 12:44-50

44 Jesus cried out and said, "He that believeth in Me, believeth not in Me, but in Him that sent Me.

45 And he that sees Me, sees Him that sent Me.

46 I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth in Me should not abide in darkness.

47 And if any man hears My words and believe not, I judge him not; for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world.

48 He that rejects Me and receive not My words, hath One that judges him; the Word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the Last Day.

49 For I have not spoken of Myself; but the Father who sent Me, He gave Me a commandment, what I should say and what I should speak.

50 I know His commandment is life everlasting. Whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said to Me, so I speak.".

In Focus

What miracles or divine opportunities are we missing out on because we are rejecting the directions of the Lord? Who might come to know Jesus if we say Yes?

The Trinity: One thing we know about God is that He is a God of relationship. In some ways God is a relationship. We can see this in God as **Trinity**. The **Father** relates to the **Son**. The **Son** relates to the **Father** and the **Spirit** relates to **Father** and **Son**.
