Pulpit Committee

We are excited to invite you to consider a significant opportunity within the First Mount Zion Baptist Church - joining the Pulpit Committee. This committee plays a pivotal role in shaping the spiritual leadership of our church by undertaking the following responsibilities:

- · Seeking and evaluating candidates for the Pastor position.
- · Identifying and presenting qualified candidates to the congregation.
- \cdot Arranging for candidate presentations to the church members.
- · Developing guidelines for these presentations.

In line with our Constitution and Bylaws, the committee will be composed of seven (7) voting members, including a Deacon, a Deaconess, a Trustee, and four (4) atlarge members from our congregation, alongside one (1) non-voting recorder. We are committed to forming a committee that reflects the diverse perspectives of our church family, and this is where your participation becomes invaluable. To facilitate this, we have prepared a survey that will take about 20 minutes of your time. This survey is designed to capture the qualities we value in Pulpit Committee members and to gather the following:

- Demographic information.

- Any additional skills you can bring to enhance the committee's efforts.

1. Spiritual Maturity and Godly Example

Specific Criteria: Demonstrates regular participation in worship services, Bible study groups, and other spiritual growth activities. Offers testimonials of personal faith journey and examples of living out faith in daily life.

2. Active Membership in Good Standing

Specific Criteria: Maintains active membership for a minimum of [specific time period, e.g., 2 years] prior to the selection. Regularly attends church services and participates in church activities/events.

3. Representation of Diversity and Interests

Specific Criteria: Demonstrates understanding and advocacy for diverse perspectives within the church, including but not limited to age, gender, education, and ministry involvement.

4. Commitment to Prayer, Study, Service, and Discernment Specific Criteria: Regular engagement in personal prayer, Bible study, church service projects, and displays wisdom in making thoughtful decisions.

5. Cooperative and Respectful Work Ethic Specific Criteria: History of working well in team settings, evidence of respectful communication, and ability to contribute constructively to group discussions.

Capturing Ministry Moments

the consent of a parent or legal guardian. Please see the following instructions for capturing landscape-oriented pictures and videos with a resolution of 19209x1080:

For Smartphones:

1. Open Camera App:

- Locate and open your camera app on your smartphone.

2. Check Settings:

- Look for a settings icon or option within the camera app (usually represented by a gear or similar icon).

3. Select Resolution:

- Find the option for "Resolution," "Video Quality," or similar.
- Choose "1920x1080" or "1080p" for videos.

4. Hold Phone Horizontally:

- Hold your phone horizontally, ensuring the longer side is left to right. This is the landscape orientation.

5. Focus and Capture:

- Tap on the screen where you want to focus, and then press the shutter button to take photos or start recording videos.

For Digital Cameras:

- 1. Turn On Camera:
- Power on your digital camera.
- 2. Access Menu:
- Navigate to the menu using the buttons or touchscreen on your camera.
- 3. Select Resolution:
- Look for a setting related to "Resolution" or "Image Size."
- Choose "1920x1080" or "1080p" for videos.

4. Hold Camera Horizontally:

- Hold your camera horizontally, ensuring the wider side is left to right.

5. Adjust Focus:

- If needed, use the autofocus feature by half-pressing the shutter button to focus on your subject.

- 6. Capture Photos or Videos:
- Fully press the shutter button to capture photos or start recording videos.

Remember, these are general instructions, and the exact steps might vary based on your specific device. Refer to your smartphone or camera's user manual for more detailed and model-specific guidance.

Vanco On-line Giving

VANCO, FMZBC's on-line giving **and mobile app**. platform, operates with an elevated level of security. As a result, access to users on the same network (FMZ IP address) will be blocked. When off site individual users may be

denied access temporarily because of too many failed login attempts. After some

time (up to 4 hours) the account will automatically reset to allow users to select the forgotten password option. To avoid this issue onsite please consider using the VANCO/FMZ mobile app for giving. As a Vanco registered user you should see this option when you sign in. You may also access the app using the following QR code.

Note: the development of the mobile app is ongoing to include the inclusion of a text box to enter your FMZ membership number. Using the mobile app is encouraged if you are onsite and blocked from the VANCO site. Instead revert to using your mobile data.

ATTENTION ALL ZOOM MEETING HOSTS: To protect our ministries from potential "Zoom bombing" by miscreants and hackers, it is no longer recommended to post- meeting ID and passcodes to the website or social media. As an alternative, Zoom offers a registration feature for meeting participants to register for a meeting using a registration link. Once the registration link is established by the host, the link can be shared as usual via Connection Points, email, text, etc. The organizer/host will receive a roster of registrants and, if necessary, can use the list to verify people before they are

allowed in the meeting.
