<u>Objective:</u> We continue to examine "Stewardship" as a part of First Mount Zion's Four-Step Strategy for accomplishing our mission "to connect people who have a desire to become fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ." <u>Summary:</u> Stewardship is not just about money. It encompasses a "whole-life" view touching virtually every aspect of life and everything God puts into our hands. Psalm 24:1 proclaims that "the earth is the Lord's and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it" (NIV). Theologian R.C. Sproul states, "stewardship is about exercising our God-given dominion over His creation, reflecting the image of our creator God in His care, responsibility, maintenance, protection, and beautification of His creation." For the believer, stewardship is not an option, but a responsibility.
